## **EUROPEAN BARS INITIATE TWINNING PROJECTS**



Lech Wafesa and CCBE President Maria Ślązak presided on 29 May to the signing of two twinning agreements between the Georgian Bar Association and the National Council of Legal Advisors in Poland, and between the Czech Bar Association and the Chamber of Advocates of the Republic of Armenia. These agreements are expected
